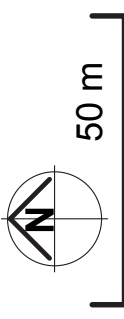

Accessible Recreation

A Liberty Swing for people with limited mobility is located at the Burke Street Playground in Burke Street, Warragul. The park also features:

- a range of new play and multi sensory equipment
- Paths that make all features of the park connected and accessible
- Accessible table and chair settings in quite areas and for viewing of park activities
- A BBQ picnic shelter
- Sensory garden beds

The key to the Liberty Swing is available at the Warragul Leisure Centre, alternatively for people with a disability your own personal key can be made available by calling Baw Baw Shire.

Warragul Leisure Centre

A Warm Water Pool is available for use at the Warragul Leisure Centre, Burke Street, Warragul. A session in this pool can relieve muscle aches and pain, aid rehabilitation, increase flow to joints and improve flexibility. Aquatic exercise programs are run in the pool.

Two Towns Trail

The Two Towns Trail is an 8km walking and cycling pathway linking the two towns of Drouin and Warragul. The trail travels between Civic Park in Drouin and Rotary Park in Warragul. The majority of the surface is a high quality three metre wide path, with some short sections of the path on low-volume, low-speed roads.
