Kerb Ramps

Penrith City Council has collated information on gradients for all kerb ramps in the St Marys Town Centre area.

The kerb ramps you see on this map marked in **brown colour** will be **difficult** to negotiate. Ramps in **blue** should be **easy** to negotiate.

Automatic Teller Machines (ATM)

The ATMs plotted on this map have been lowered to enable people with disabilities to access them from a wheelchair. All ATMs have visual text prompts as well as written instructions posted nearby.
