

## Rose Point Park

Rose Point Park All Abilities Playground is open to everyone all year round. It is a fenced off playground that has play equipment that meets the vast abilities of all children and is a lovely relaxing place for the whole family to get together and relax. Rose Point Park facilities include: accessible toilets, footpaths, accessible picnic tables, bbq facilities, flying fox, giraffe swing, Liberty Swing, basket swings and a high swing. Soft fall is around most of the play equipment. An MLAK key is required for the Liberty Swing.

(Toilet / Carpark / ramp entrance / level entrance / automatic door)

**Town Plaza:** Gowrie Street, Singleton  
(Toilet / Carpark / level entrance / automatic door)
